Advanced students registered for all three days will perform solo and group music together for the final concert.

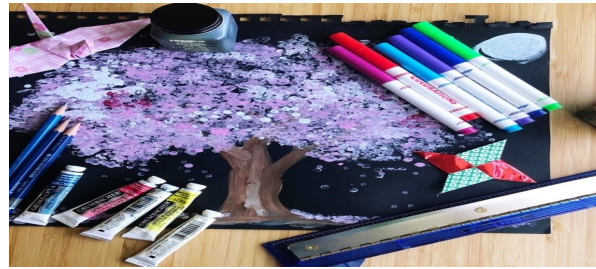

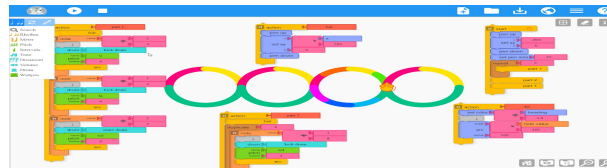
