# Looking into purchasing a guitar?

As for guitars, these are the type of guitars that I recommend because they are very nice for the price. These are the packages that are recommended for my students:

1/2 size\* YAMAHA CGS guitar (or Cordoba), footstool, music stand, case

3/4 size\* YAMAHA CGS guitar (or Cordoba), footstool, music stand, case

# **Budget Concerns?**

The instruments and materials above typically cost under \$200. However, if you cannot afford the guitar now, I do not recommend purchasing a cheaper instrument. Rather, you should consider saving up for one of these entry-level Yamaha's/Cordoba's. Some of the cheaper instruments are not good for the hands or ears of young students.

#### Which brands do you not recommend?

Please do not buy First Act brand guitars. These are not constructed in a way that the instrument will sound "in-tune". Students will become frustrated that, despite all their effort, the sound from the guitar is not accurate.

### **Strings?**

I recommed purchasing strings, footstools, and other guitar equipment from Strings By Mail at <u>www.stringsbymail.com</u> They are knowledgeable and focus on the items that you need for guitar class.

Students should typically change their strings every 3-6 months.
